## 'Change It!'

You'll need four different coloured counters. Each colour represents a sound within the word.

Given a word, the pupil will change the initial, final or medial sound to form a new word.

Adult says: "This represents c/a/t (pushing three different coloured counters). Now change the /c/to/p/. What new word do you have?"

e.g. If this says c/a/t/ change the /c/ to // what new word do you have?

e.g. If this says b/e/t change the /t/ to // change the /ai/ t
