#### **Phonics**



Learning Objective: Phonics-RWI/Mark making

m, a, s, t, d, i

Please encourage your child to copy those sounds.

Find things around your house/garden that begin with the 'n' sound. Practice saying the 'n'. Trace the letter that makes the 'n' sound up in the air, on the floor, in your palm or on each other's back.

Then try to write the sound 'n' on paper.
