Group 2

sight, send, clock, bee, sheet, brown, think, quit, felt.

Group 3

computer, window, strong, rink, lamp, fright, clown, growl.

A box has got a lock.

Group 2

The clock struck midnight and it was cold.

The cow was brown and stood on the grass.

Group 3

"I like hearing the rain on the window" said Miss Annison, "maybe the sun will come out too and there will be a rainbow."
