- Each day – Talk about the weather. What is the weather like today?
- After 2 or 3 days look at the series of photos. Has the weather changed? How? What can you see in the sky?

Maths



Build a tower – what can you use?

Find some objects to build a tower. Does it stand up without you holding it?

Challenge- label each part of the tower with a number, muddle the bricks up- can your child build the tower starting with brick 1 and building them in order to 10?

For support, show your child a number line 1-10 and use it together to count along each time your child needs to find the next number- what number have we found? So, what number comes next?
