

SECURE START INTERVENTION AND PHONOLOGICAL AWARENESS TRAINING

Phonics, reading and writing intervention for children who are not securing early literacy skills including single letter sounds



This intervention can be delivered in short sessions and used for individuals at KS1/Y3 pupils (L & S - Phase 1-2 moving into Phase 3). The course includes:

- Baseline assessments to identify pupil's strengths and needs
- Understanding phonological awareness difficulties
- Phonological awareness scheme of work
- Exemplar teaching of Secure Start Intervention
- Strategies for developing rapid recognition and recall of phonemes, word blending and segmentation
- Approaches to early reading and high frequency word recognition
- Early handwriting strategies
- Games and apps/software to consolidate learning
