Theme of the week – Fairy Tales



Phonics



Learning Objective: Phonics-RWI/Mark making

The sounds that we have learnt so far are:

m, a, s, t, d, i, n

Please encourage your child to copy those sounds.

This week's sound is 'p'



**Rhyme: Down the pirate's plait
and around his face.**

Find things around your house/garden that begin with the 'p' sound. Practice saying the 'p'. Trace the letter that makes the 'p' sound up in the air, on the floor, in your palm or on each other's back. Then try to write the sound 'p' on paper.

Challenge: How many objects starting with the 'p' sound did you find?

Polly Put the Kettle On

Maths

Write the numbers 1-10 on pieces of paper/card and hide them around the house. Go on a hunt and collect all the cards then put them in order. If your child finds it difficult to recognise some of the numbers, draw pictures for them to count.

Challenge: Point out one of the number cards and ask your child 'What number comes before it?' 'What number come after it?'

Mark making

Take a sheet of paper and draw a little car park on it. Mark out enough spaces for the letters of your child's name. Add the letters, in order, to each space. Then select some toy cars and add a sticker with the corresponding letters on to each car.



Challenge – practice writing your name in rainbow colours, using the correct letter formation.

Eco Challenge:

Make some Goldilocks and The Three Bears characters from toilet roll tubes:



Make a shape crown using recycled materials
