Earth Day – April 22<sup>nd</sup> 2020. This year celebrates 50 years of Earth day, which creates awareness of the environment and how we treat nature.

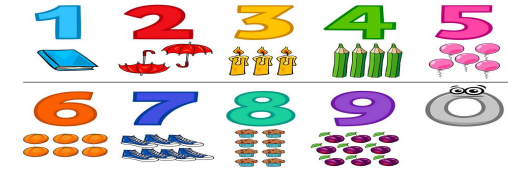
Draw a poster about how we can help our planet.
