New sounds– ee, igh, ow (teach these sounds and then continue to revise them) These sounds can be found in words such as See, tree, high, light, brown, down.

Start my reading group 1 then move up the groups to build you confidence and knowledge Read these words by blending the sounds

Group 1

map, can, lad, fox, mop, no, lip, kit, flip, ban, up, see, free

Group 2

lid, night, lend, chips, shoot, bend, quick, bees, light, cow

Group 3

comic, ribbon, strop, bucket, seven, robin, how, been, bright

Read these sentences

Group 1

Fox sat on a log.
A map can help us.

Group 2

The night is dark and the cows go to sleep.
Bees like to visit flowers and collect pollen.

Group 3

“My bucket is full” said Robin with a shout, “I want to go back down now”.
The ribbon was a bright green colour and had been wrapped seven times around the tree.
