WHAT OUR DAY LOOKS LIKE

BUSY FINGERS

The children start the day with busy fingers, a fine motor skills intervention. This helps the muscles to develop in our fingers.



MESSY PLAY

Children explore a wide range of different textures such as shaving foam, slime, cornflour and mousse.



MARK MAKING

Our children follow the letters and sounds phonics programme. This helps them to understand their letters and be able to write sentences. The children enjoy describing the marks they make..



CHILD INITIATED LEARNING

This is an important role in children's learning and development. Our children explore and learn from their own thoughts and ideas through the freedom and creativity that child-initiated learning and play enables.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What do I need to bring every day?

Book bag, water bottle and coat

How do I communicate with the class teacher?

Speaking to them at the class door, email, parents consultations and our online portal [Tapestry](#).

How do I know what my child did at school?

Observations will be uploaded to Tapestry and sent to you weekly. We also have a twitter account that will share information with you.

What does my child eat for lunch?

All Reception children are entitled to free school meals and have a choice of three options daily.

What time does school start and finish?

8.40-9.00 and 3.00 -3.20 (due to COVID and staggered)

What if my child is hungry in the morning?

Fruit is provided everyday

Do you still go out in the rain?

Yes please provide a coat for your child and a pair of wellies which will be left at school. Spare clothes should also be left at school.

How does my child express their feelings in school?

Using the zones of regulation board

Will Reception go on school trips?

Yes, previously Reception have gone on trips such the pantomime and the farm.

My child has asthma and an epi-pen what do I do?

Complete medical forms with the school office. Staff are first aid trained

What do I do if I'm worried about something?

Speak to class teacher or EYFS Leader

Pick up/drops off

Please let class teacher or school office know if someone different is picking up or dropping off as need to safeguard your child

Is there a PTA?

Yes, every parent at the school can be a member.

Is there any homework in Reception?

Yes set weekly

How do I know what my child is learning every week?

A weekly newsletter is sent home explaining what we are learning for the week

Reception class doors
