Reception key skills for this week.

Create patterns (repeating colour or number patterns)
Use positional language (under, over, behind, next to, in front of) when in conversation.

Describe 2D and 3D shapes and talk about their properties. Shape hunt in your house- what shape is your cereal box?

Count reliably from 1-20 and recognise these numbers.

Practical activities and discussion of addition and subtraction. Try to record in a number sentence e.g $4 + 3 =$

Sing songs, make music and dance.

Showing curiosity about objects, events and people.

Persisting with an activity when challenges occur.

Continues a rhyming string.

Writes labels, captions and short sentences.
