




Pages 12–13 Adverbs and Adverbials

5	I still did not know whether it was best to be early for my audition or arrive at the appointed time.  	1
6	Answers will vary. Sentence must start with a capital letter. Fronted adverbial must be followed by a comma. Examples: <b>After a long wait</b> , we were able to congratulate the goalkeeper. <b>At last</b> , we were able to congratulate the goalkeeper. <b>Immediately</b> , they knew something was wrong. <b>After a few minutes</b> , they knew something was wrong.	1
