## SAFEGUARDING YOUR CHILD ON GOOGLE CLASSROOM

We are working hard to ensure that Google Classroom is a safe online resource for the children at Laurance Haines.

Please be aware of the following items:

- Its wonderful to see so many of the children attending however entry to the Google Meets will be denied for any non Laurance Haines account even if it is a child
- During the Google Meets, cameras must be turned on to safeguard who is attending, so that there can be an attendance taken and so staff can interact and connect as much as possible
- Unfortunately staff can not respond to emails sent from the Google account. If you wish to speak to your child's teacher via email please use the normal school email and they will be happy to help
- We are working hard to ensure that the virtual Google Meets are secure however children are still accessing the meet before and after the session. We understand that children really need time to talk and staff are working to build that in during the day safely. In the meantime please notify the teacher your child accesses a classroom with a staff member by email or by calling school and take your child off immediately.

## ACCESSING GOOGLE CLASSROOM

Google Classrooms can be accessed via a laptop, tablet or phone.

If you do not have access to these you can also access Google Classrooms via a PlayStation or XBox.

## BBC BITESIZE

Starting on Monday 11 January, each week day on CBBC will see a three-hour block of primary school programming from 9am, including BBC Live Lessons and BBC Bitesize Daily, as well as other educational programming such as Our School and Celebrity Supply Teacher and much loved titles such as Horrible Histories, Art Ninja and Operation Ouch.

BBC Two will cater for secondary students with programming to support the GCSE curriculum, with a least two hours of content each weekday.

Content will be built around Bitesize Daily secondary shows, complemented by Shakespeare and classic drama adaptations alongside science, history and factual titles from the BBC's award-winning factual programming units.

Bitesize Daily primary and secondary will also air every day on BBC Red Button as well as episodes being available on demand on BBC iPlayer.

For primary, BBC Bitesize online has an expanded offer of structured lessons in Maths and English for all year groups - these can be used at home or in the classroom. 'This Term's Topics' also covers other curriculum subjects and curates learning content that works for the Spring curriculum. This content can be easily incorporated into a learning plan or used to explore different topics at home.
