Magic moments.

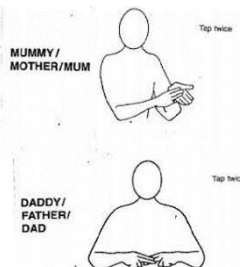
We would love to hear about special magic moments that happen at home. Has your child said something very smart? Have you got some exciting news to tell us? Would you like to tell us about a day out?

Tapestry is now up and running. Please make sure you do this as soon as possible as your activation will expire in 20 days and will then require a new code sent by the school.

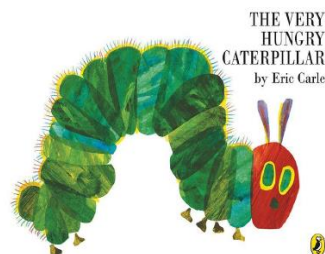
You will receive an observation every week of a round up of your child's week!
