Home learning

Maths

For maths next week we are learning to compare numbers 1,2,3 and learning about the composition of numbers 1,2 and 3.

Challenge-

Discuss with your child what numbers go into 3. For example, 1,1,1 or 2,1.

Activity: you will need 3 rolled up socks made into a ball shape and a bucket/bowl.

To play: Stand couple steps away from the bowl and try to throw the socks to get it in the bowl. Write the score of how many you got in the bowl and how many you got out. You can continue this game with 4 or 5 socks if you feel confident. Try playing with a family member for extra fun.

Topic

Our topic this term is **Winter Wonder Land.**

Throughout the children Own Learning time we will be exploring all things to do with winter and the seasonal changes.

Next week is **World Nursery Rhyme Week.** Instead of Book of the Week we will be learning nursery rhymes.
