Magic moments.

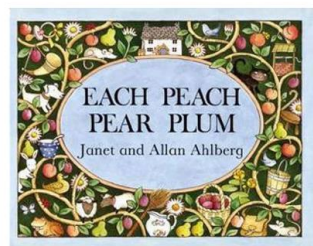
We would love to hear about special magic moments that happen at home. Has your child said something very smart? Have you got some exciting news to tell us? Would you like to tell us about a day out?

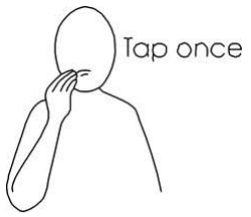
