

Next week in maths we exploring the composition of the number 5. We will be looking at all the different ways you can make 5.

Challenge – How many different ways can you make the number 5 with objects from your home. EG – 3 carrots and 2 bottles or 4 socks and 1 hair brush.

Can you write this in a number sentence? For example:

$$3 + 2 = 5 \quad 4 + 1 = 5$$
