These are the first words on the Year 3 / 4 spelling list. Please can you learn the following this week at home:



Use 'Look - Cover - Write - Check' to practise the words and then write them within a full sentence.




## Maths:

Next week we're looking at intervals on a number line. Can you work out what the missing numbers are?






