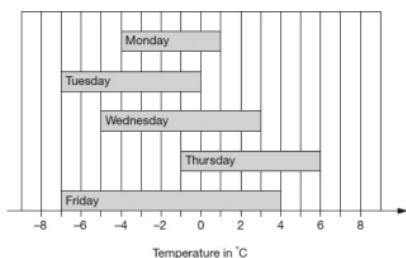
### Reading:
